- From Highway 99, take Highway 178 exit heading east.
- Turn left (stop light) on Fairfax Avenue (just east of the Oswell Exit).
- At the bottom of the hill, turn right onto Alfred Harrel Highway heading east.
- Go 4 miles to Hart Park.
- Race start is just inside park entrance on the right.
